

Mythogenic: Pseudo- sensate manifestation of shared trans-personal mythology
expressing mutual projections/expectations
(Church)

Mytho-Poetic: Pseudo-Mythic manifestation derived from sensate phenomena
(Beautiful Sunset)

Metaphysical: Pseudo-sensate manifestation of trans-phenomenal reality
(Burning Bush)

Mystery: Pseudo-mythic manifestation of trans-phenomenal reality
(Trinity)

MESSAGE

Narrative Level: Story of what was said and done, what was remembered of and by whom. (Literal/historical level)

Contextual Level: Historical setting, cultural context etc.

Lexegetical Level: Mechanics of transmission/communication (Language/semantics)

Mythogenic Level: What was believed about the narrative, and how has that belief impacted the narrative over time. (Theological level)

Intentional Level: Why did the author think he was writing this particular text.
Instructions about practical matters of daily life.

MEANING

Mytho-Poetic Level: Art of transmitting/communicating the story (Psycho-Mythic Significance)

Theological Level- What does this message reveal about God?

Psychological Level: Trans-personal meaning of the narrative-what does it reveal about human nature and impact our relationships.

Ontogenic Level: Personal meaning of the narrative.

Spiritual Level: How does this message help me encounter, respond, participate in the mystery, wisdom and beauty of God.
